PROVIDE DIVERSE HABITATS

Un-mown patches of lawn, piles of stones, logs and dried leaves, plus DIY bug hotels all create shelter for insects



PLANT SEASONAL PLANTS

Borage, rosemary, verbena, heather and ivy - just some of the plants that will ensure year-round forage for pollinators



GARDEN ORGANIC

Chemical pesticides can poison bees; companion planting is a natural way to manage pests. Leave a saucer of water out for insects to drink from.
