

# Make a Bee Drinker

How often do you feel thirsty? Especially when the weather is warm? Well, honey bees and pollinators also need water but may drown whilst trying to collect it. Here are five ways to provide them with a safe place to drink.

## A Bucket

Add a sponge to a bucket of water, float corks on the surface or dangle a cloth over the bucket rim so it's halfway in the water.

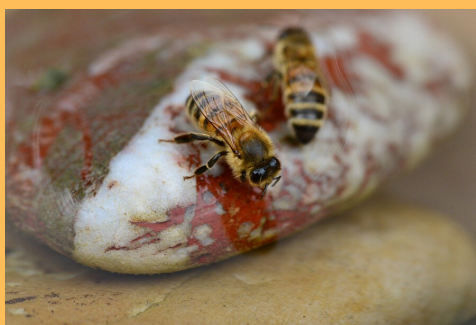
## A Bird Bath

Add stones to a pre-existing bird bath to provide landing areas for pollinators.

## A Fountain

Opt for those with a gentle current - water running over a rock or that drains into a rock-filled grate work well.



## A Saucer

Fill a shallow saucer with stones or marbles - and a little water, of course.

## A Pond

Let a container fill with rain water and add floating plants such as frogbit and broad-leaved pondweed.
